What is Criw Celf?

An art club that gives an opportunity for children who have shown talent and/or a special interest in art to develop their skills and experiences in an art gallery.



Who will lead the sessions?

The club employs professional and experienced artists who all have DBS checks to lead the sessions.

What does membership include?

Members will attend a programme of one-day master classes in the company of professional artists who specialise in various art disciplines. 6-8 days training will be held across the year on Saturdays between 11am-3.30pm at Oriel Myrddin Gallery, Carmarthen.



Each young artist will receive an art pack containing a variety of art materials. The purpose of providing these packs is to enable the children to practice drawing at home.

A selected exhibition of the children's artwork will be staged at the end of the year.

Is there a charge?

The scheme is subsidised by the Local Authority and the Arts Council for Wales and every child will be required to pay an annual membership fee of £30.

Recipients of Free School Meals are entitled to a reduction in membership fee to support them to take part.



It is the responsibility of parents to transport their children to and from the sessions and to provide packed lunches.

How to apply:

There are 25 places available and each primary school can nominate up to 10 pupils who have shown a special talent and/or interest in art to become a member of Criw Celf. Individual applications from pupils outside of mainstream education are also welcomed.

Every child nominated will need to submit the following for assessment:

- A 2D self-portrait, created using any art material or combination of art materials. (No more than A3 sized paper)
- A drawing of the view from any window in their home, created using any art material or combination of art materials. (No more than A3 sized paper)
- A short paragraph explaining why they would like to join Criw Celf? (No more than 50 words)

- All applications must include name, age, school and home address. Please include the form below, completed and secured to each child's application. Ensure name is written on each item for submission.

Please note: We will not be able to contact any applicants who do not provide an address! Artwork will be returned to the schools after selection.
