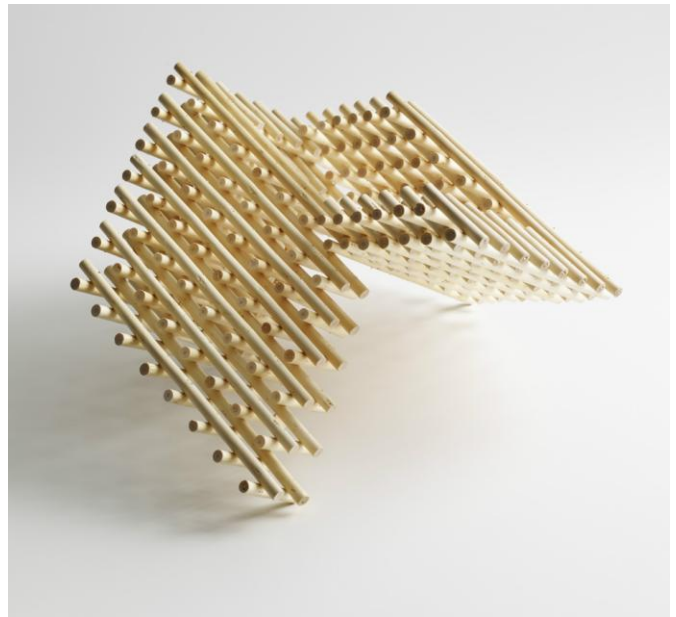


**Teachers' Private View
